OUR PARTICIPATION CONTRACT WITH YOU

1. Support workers will ask each young person, "What was good, and what could be better?" about the service they received.
2. These commitments will be shared with every young person who uses our service, to show we're committed to involving them.
3. Commitments will also be shared in the spaces that we work and online.
4. We'll offer rewards such as food or money for their contributions to show that we value their time and input.
5. We'll provide education sessions to help young people understand their rights and how to make the most of opportunities to use their voice.
6. We'll promote safe ways for young people to share their experiences, find support or communicate concerns including anonymous reporting.
7. We'll support interested young people to act as Peer Listeners, learning how to hear and share the voices of other young people in our service.
8. Young people can always talk to any trusted worker they know and feel comfortable with, to share what was good and what we could improve.
