Course content:

This course looks at cocaine and crack and other commonly used stimulants. The course will look at:

- trends in stimulant use
- differences between cocaine and crack and other stimulants
- indicators of use
- key risks and risk screening:
 - lifestyle, criminality and debt
 - physical health
 - mental health
 - polydrug use
 - risk to others
 - dependency
- primary harm reduction
- signposting
- key aspects of stimulant treatment and recovery

Who the course is for:

Anybody encountering cocaine, crack or other stimulant use either with users or affected others.

The course is especially relevant for people who need to feel confident in identifying problematic aspects of stimulant use, undertaking brief interventions and referring in to other agencies as required.

We recommend completing the Basic Drug Awareness training course prior to attending the Cocaine, Crack and other stimulants training.
