



Safer Camborne/Safer Redruth Delivery Plan 2019/2020

The aim of Safer Camborne/Safer Redruth is to **improve community safety and reduce crime and anti-social behaviour** by targeting persistent problem places and people within the geographical area and work with **communities, partners and the business and voluntary sectors** to develop **sustainable solutions**.

Safer Camborne/Safer Redruth will facilitate and support a co-ordinated multi-agency approach to community safety issues to improve public reassurance, reduce the risk of harm to the community and protect vulnerable groups. Communities will be involved in the work of the partnership which will encourage social inclusion and community participation through being part of the problem-solving process. Achieving safer communities depends upon everyone working together to find local solutions to local problems.

Based on the evidence presented in the Camborne and Redruth Town Profiles and feedback from the Residents Survey, the following have been identified as community safety priorities for the towns:

1	Domestic Abuse & Sexual Violence
2	ASB - Camborne & Redruth Town Centres
3	Alcohol & Drug-related Harm and Recovery
4	Provision for Young People
5	Community Engagement and Building Community Resilience

These priorities will be addressed through this delivery plan. Progress will be measured through achievement of quarterly and annual milestones over the lifetime of the plan and key deliverables/outcomes will be reported to the Safer Cornwall Partnership
